The Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received credit from the International Development Association towards the cost of Sindh Irrigated Agriculture Productivity Enhancement Project and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the contract for work of construction of 50 Natural Enemy Farm Reservoir (NEFR) Sheds.
- 2. The Project Director Sindh Irrigated Agriculture Productivity Enhancement Project invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of 50 Natural Enemy Farm Reservoirs (NEFR) Sheds at following 5 districts of Sindh Province:
 - District Thatta
 - District Larkana
 - District Sanghar
 - District Tando Allahyar
 - District Mirpurkhas
- 3. Bidding documents may be purchased from the Office of Project Director ,Sindh Irrigated Agriculture Productivity Enhancement Project ,Sindh Seed Corporation Building, Ground Floor, Main Hussainabad Road, Hussainabad Hyderabad for a nonrefundable fee of Rs 2000/= for each set in the shape of pay order/bank draft in the name of Project Director SIAPEP. The deadline date for issuing the bidding document is one (01) working day before the opening date. Interested bidders may obtain further information from same address.
- 5. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security of 2% (in the shape of pay order/bank draft in the name of Project Director SIAPEP) of the Bid Price and shall be delivered to Project Director, Sindh Irrigated Agriculture Productivity Enhancement Project, Sindh Seed Corporation Building, Ground Floor, Main Hussainabad Road, Hussainabad Hyderabad on or before 20-05-2019 at 11:00 am. The submitted bids will be opened

on the same day at 11:30 am PST in the presence of authorized representative of the firms who wish to attend.

- 6. The procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method in accordance with paragraph 3.3 of "Guidelines Procurement Of Goods, Works, And Non-Consulting Services Under IBRD Loans And IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers
- 7. A pre-bid conference will be held at <u>29-04-2019 at 11:30 am</u> in the office of the Project Director, Sindh Irrigated Agriculture Productivity Enhancement Project The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify site and various other issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage. All potential Bidders that have obtained the Bidding Documents are invited to attend.
- 8. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.
- 9. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide a total price. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid.
- 10. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected.
- 11. As provided in the bidding documents, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/pooling) will be declared ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
