Terms & Conditions

- a. The firm will be selected by the farmer from the published pre-selected list of firms.
- b. The firm will negotiate and enter into contract with the farmer for supply of the equipment;
- c. The equipment supplied will be as per the approved sample (complete set as per specifications provided in the EoI) on turnkey basis (equipment supply, operation demonstration and handing over etc.);
- d. The firm will provide access to one complete set of approved equipment, which will be used as reference for monitoring the quality of the units delivered to the farmers/ service providers;
- e. The Firm will organize product and services information melas coordinated by Deputy Directors (OFWM) in the districts for introduction / exhibition / demonstration of approved equipment to the farmers to facilitate for selecting the Deep Ripping Equipment unit/Firm. The venue will be organized by the Project;
- f. Grower/Farmer will negotiate the price, delivery time and book their equipment with the Firm of choice and will issue advice / work order to the concerned Firm under intimation to PD SIAPEP, Director/Upper/Lower & concerned Deputy Director for supply of booked Equipment. He will then submit his / her entire share as original bank draft, drawn in favor of selected Firm to the Project Director SIAPEP; within one month of date of award;
- g. The project's contribution to the total price per unit will be i) PKR 67,500 or ii) 45% of the purchase price- whichever is lesser;
- h. The delivery of the unit will be made at the project designated venue specified in the Work Order;
- i. The Firm will ensure delivery of booked Deep Ripping Equipment unit within stipulated period;
- j. In case of failure of Firm to deliver the unit within specified time, the farmer will have the choice to book the unit with any other pre-selected Firm based on published list available at Project website and also available on request through mail;
- k. Inspection Committee constituted by the Project Director SIAPEP will jointly carry out inspection of the complete Deep Ripping Equipment unit and record complete information in the Technical Inspection Report on specified format for ensuring quality of the supplied unit;
- The Validation Report issued by PSIAC and signed by all the members of inspection committee will be sent to the Project Director SIAPEP for payment.
- m. Firm will send the invoice to farmer with its copy to Project Director SIAPEP.

- n. Subsidy from Project shall be paid to the supplier through farmer using payment channels that are aligned with the process which could be branchless (digital transfers).
- Based on the agreement with farmer, Firm will be bound to provide after sale services during and after the warranty period. The Firm will ensure availability of Service Centers in Sindh province to facilitate the stakeholders;
- p. The Firm with repeated instance of poor quality will be removed from the published Pre-Selection List.
- q. New firms will be added to the list on an ongoing basis
